Chris Taylor is an adjunct associate professor in Georgetown’s Security Studies Program where he teaches The Business of National Security and co-teaches Hacking for Defense.

A global business leader and entrepreneur, Chris is the CEO of Govini, a big data and analytics company focused on transforming the business of government through data science. He is also Senior Advisor for the Managing Director of MD5 - The National Security Technology Accelerator at the Pentagon.

Chris spent 14 years in the U.S. Marine Corps as an enlisted infantryman and Force Recon Marine. Twice selected for meritorious promotion, he was the Distinguished Honor Graduate at the NCO Leadership Academy, the Distinguished Leadership Graduate at Amphibious Reconnaissance School, and the Class Commander at Marine Combatant Diver Course 93-40.

Chris holds an MBA from the College of William & Mary where he received the Dean’s Award for Leadership and Service at graduation. He is also a graduate of the Harvard Kennedy School, where he earned a Master of Public Administration degree in Political Economy and International Security, and was chosen by his class to lead them into Harvard Yard for graduation.

Chris speaks frequently at professional and academic forums, and has testified before Congress and the Commission on Wartime Contracting on private sector contributions to national security. Chris is a member of the Board of Trustees of the American University of Afghanistan, the Council on Foreign Relations, and the Atlantic Council.
