Mr Michael Stoltz was appointed as Director AMDC2 in the NCI Agency on 1 July 2017. This Directorate combined all responsibilities for the delivery of the AirC2 and BMD Programmes. In July 2016 he was appointed as Acting Director having been Deputy Director and Chief Programme Implementation Branch from June 2013.

From 1997 – 2013, Mr Stoltz worked at the NATO Programming Centre (NPC) in a number of posts. As the Chief Technology Officer (CTO), Mr Stoltz represented the technical interests of NPC at relevant NATO committees and conferences, acting as primary technical point of contact for Industry. In the position of Principal Technical Advisor at NPC, he was responsible for the NPC Engineering Group and, in this role, he established the Integrated System Support Concept as the framework for supporting NATO ACCS. Before this, he participated in the ACCS LOC1 procurement activities and acted as a technical advisor to the NATO ACCS Management Agency and the Nations. Mr Stoltz worked for more than a year as technical liaison to the Thales-Raytheon Systems Industry team in Paris/France.

Mr Stoltz earned a Master's degree in Computer Science from the German University of the Armed Forces in Munich. He has remained actively involved in the systematic analysis of complex systems with computer based tools.
